AN ACT

RELATING TO ENGINEERS AND SURVEYORS; AMENDING SECTION 54-1230, IDAHO CODE, TO CLARIFY THAT PRIVATE LAND SURVEYORS MAY ACCESS PRIVATE LANDS AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 54-1230, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

54-1230. PUBLIC SURVEYING -- RIGHT OF ENTRY. (1) Any person or his subordinate employed in the execution of any survey authorized by the congress of the United States or authorized by Idaho law may enter upon or go over lands within this state for the purpose of exploring, triangulating, leveling, surveying, and of doing any work which that may be necessary to carry out the objects of then existing laws relative to surveys, and may establish permanent station marks, and may erect the necessary signals and temporary observatories, doing no unnecessary injury thereby.

(2) Nothing in this section shall affect the right of entry established in sections 40-1310 and 40-2301, Idaho Code.

(3) A surveyor or his subordinate shall not enter railroad property pursuant to this section without written permission from the railroad's chief engineering officer or his designee.
