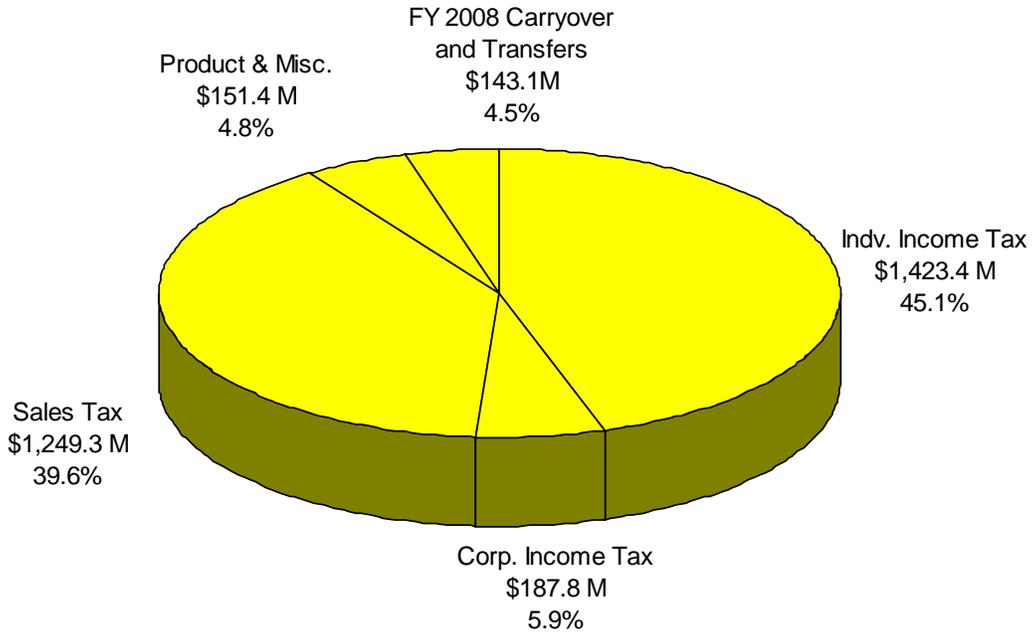

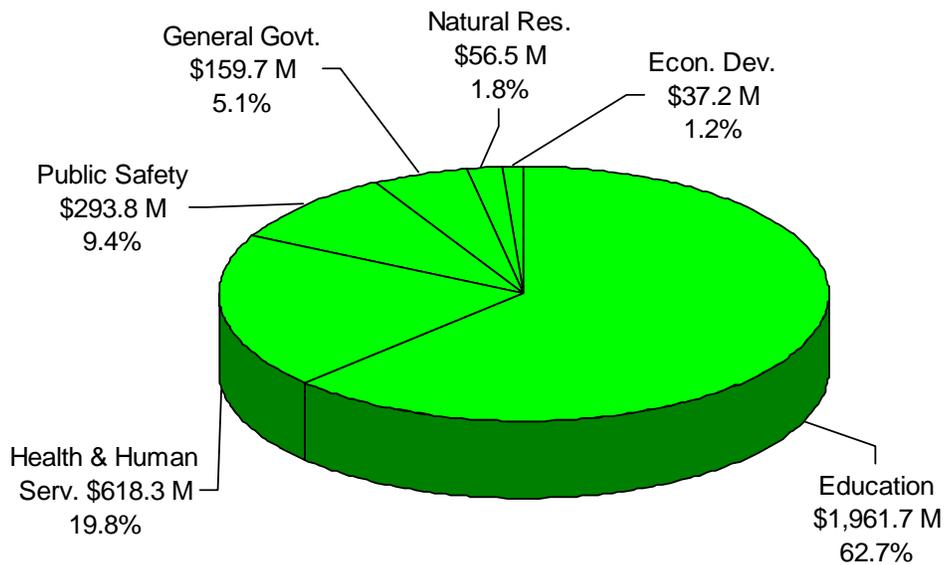

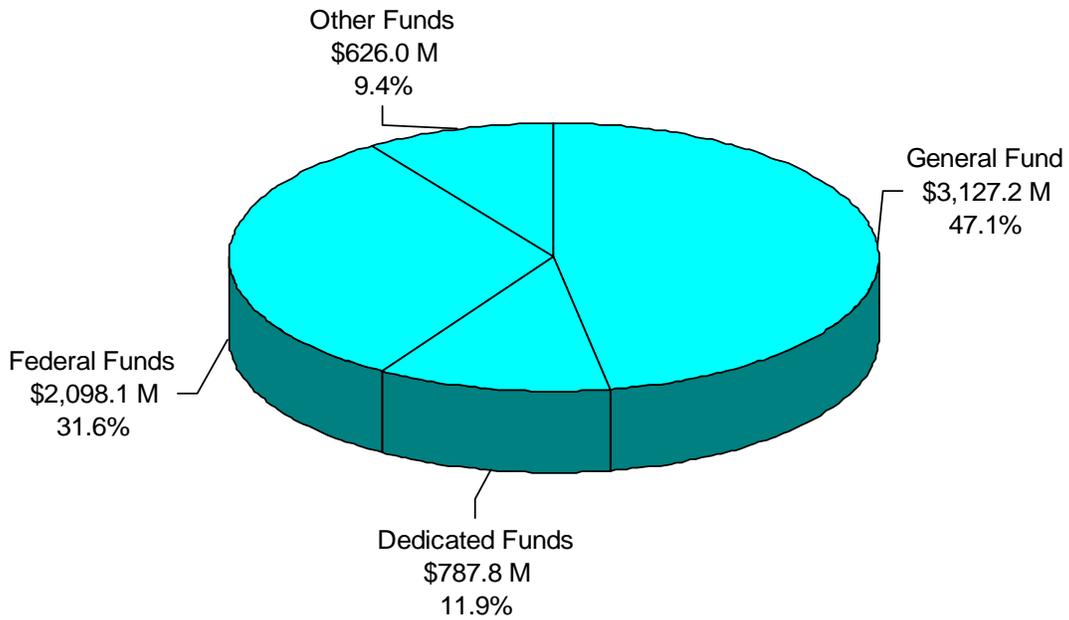
Expenditure by State Goal - \$3,127.2 Million Total



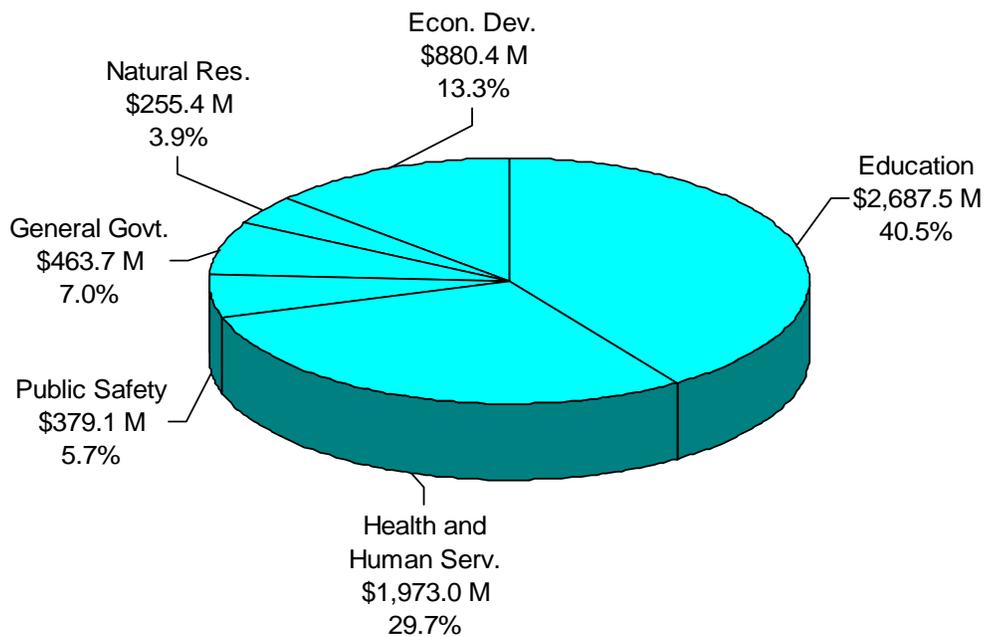
