

Part 1 – Agency Profile

Agency Overview

The Lava Hot Springs Foundation was created in 1919 to administer the State property in and around the city of Lava Hot Springs. It is governed by a five member Board of Directors appointed by the Governor to six-year terms. Mark Lowe serves as Executive Director overseeing the 9 full time employees and 55 temporary and seasonal workers who operate and maintain this world-class hot spring and recreational facility. The revenues generated by ticket sales, rentals and retail sales provide for the operation and maintenance of the approximately 200 acres deeded to the State by the Federal Government in 1902.



Core Functions/Idaho Code
