(2) The license tax imposed by this chapter only on mining operations 17 that include a cyanidation facility, as defined by section 47-1503, Idaho 18 Code, shall be paid to the state tax commission on or before the due date of 19 the return and the commission shall remit the sums to the state treasurer, 20 who shall place thirty-three percent (33%) to the credit of the general fund 21 22 of the state, thirty-three percent (33%) to the credit of the cyanidation 23 facility closure fund created by the provisions of section 47-1513, Idaho Code, and thirty-four percent (34%) sixty-seven percent (67%) to the credit 24 of the abandoned mine reclamation fund created by the provisions of section 25 47-1703, Idaho Code. 26

27 SECTION 2. That Section 47-1703, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby 28 amended to read as follows:

FUNDING. This chapter shall govern the use of state and fed-29 47-1703. eral moneys specifically appropriated for abandoned mine reclamation. This 30 chapter shall not require the state to expend or appropriate state moneys. 31 32 The board may receive federal funds, state funds, and any other funds, and, within the limits imposed by a specific grant, expend them as directed by 33 this chapter. All grants, funds, fees, fines, penalties, interest, and 34 other uncleared money which that has been or will be paid to the state for 35 abandoned mine reclamation shall be placed in the state treasury and cred-36 ited to the abandoned mine reclamation fund, which is hereby created as 37 an interest-bearing, dedicated fund. This fund shall be available to the 38 39 board, by legislative appropriation, and shall be expended for the reclamation of lands affected by eligible mining operations. 40
