SUBJECT: Executive Agency Legislative System (EALS) – 2023 Procedures

All legislation an agency is involved in must be reviewed and approved by the Division of Financial Management (DFM) and the Governor's Office to determine consistency with gubernatorial policies, and to assess the impact on state agencies and the public. <u>All</u> legislation bearing an agency, or agency employee, name must go through the Executive Agency Legislation System (EALS) process.

Manual and Training Session

Enclosed is the 2023 Executive Agency Legislation process manual which provides updated instructions on developing legislation. The following deadlines apply for all legislation agencies intend to bring forth during the 2024 Idaho legislative session:
